

Monday, November 28, 2022 - For the first time since 1995, the B. B. Comer Memorial High School football team will compete for the state championship. The Tigers defeated Highland Home on Friday, November 23 with a score of 44-15 at home to secure the championship berth. B. B. Comer will face Fyffe on Friday, Dec. 2 at 3:00 in Jordan-Hare Stadium (Auburn, AL). The Tiger Walk will be at 1:15 pm on Friday, December 2, 2022 in Auburn, AL. We hope the entire community will show up to cheer for the Tigers!

FAN INFORMATION for this year's game is as follows:

TICKETS: All advance ticket sales for the 2022 AHSAA Super 7 will be available for purchase online through the AHSAA's digital ticketing partner, GoFan, by visiting https://gofan.co/AHSAA and will be \$15 plus applicable GoFan fees.

PROGRAMS & CONCESSIONS: Programs and concessions will be available. *All purchases must be with debit/credit cards*.

CROWD BEHAVIOR: Profanity, racial comments or other intimidating actions directed at officials, student athletes, coaches or other team representatives will not be tolerated. This includes but is not limited to verbal comments and signage. Individuals violating this policy may be removed from the stadium.

CLEAR BAG POLICY AND WALK-THROUGH METAL DETECTORS: Clear Bag Policy and Walk Through Metal Detectors will be used at Jordan-Hare Stadium. Visit www.auburntigers.com/clearbag for more information. Fans are encouraged to arrive at Jordan-Hare Stadium gates approximately 30 minutes earlier than normal to ensure a smooth entry.

PROHIBITED ITEMS: During the ASHAA Super 7 Championships, the AHSAA will comply with all applicable Auburn University policies regarding prohibited items. Jordan-Hare Stadium and all other Auburn Athletics Facilities prohibit the following items:

- o ANY BAG (Includes back packs, purses, etc.) NOT APPROVED BY CLEAR BAG POLICY
- Coolers
- Weapons
- Artificial noisemakers (bells, horns, whistles, cow bells, etc.)
- Outside food and/or drink
- Smoking
- Umbrellas (In case of rain, bring a poncho or raincoat)
- Video recorders or camcorders

- Computers
- Cameras with telephoto lenses over 4 inches long
- Flags/Banners on poles
- Drones
- o Any other items deemed inappropriate, hazardous, or unsafe by venue personnel

PARKING: During Super 7, Auburn University will still be completing its Fall 2022 academic term, so event parking will be working around normal campus activities and Super 7 parking on the Auburn University campus will be limited before 5 p.m. each day.

For the B. B. Comer game, fans can park in designated (on <u>parking map</u>) Auburn University parking lot on a first-come, first-serve basis in addition to the parking lots serviced by shuttles detailed above. For the 2A game, all Super 7 parking will be directed to the Hay Field Lot at Donahue Drive and Lem Morrison as well as the Seed Processing Plant Lot located at Donahue Drive and College Street. Complimentary shuttle service on Tiger Transit will be available Friday to transport you to and from the stadium at this location.

There will be restricted event parking areas associated with the Super 7 State Championships and those with access will be issued an event parking pass. If you have a parking pass it must be visible on the dashboard at all times.

Any fans attending Super 7 that display a current state-issued and valid handicapped tag or placard will allow them to park in any designated handicapped areas on campus or utilize the "Red Barn Lot" off of Donahue Drive or Tiger Transit vehicles from the shuttle locations will be equipped to manage ADA guests.
