Parent Information

- Student's first day of school will be August 20, 2020. Black Day students will report on Thursday, August 20 and Gold Day students will report on August 21. Our full rotation will begin on Monday, August 24, 2020.
- Black Day students are those with a last name that begins with A-K. Gold Day students are those with a last name that begins with L-Z. These splits are based on our student population and households.

- All students, traditional and virtual, must complete PowerSchool registration. The link for PowerSchool registration can be found [here](#). New students, including kindergarten students, will need to create an account. Returning students will need their snap code. You can contact the school at 256-315-2565 or email julie.lundy@tcboe.org or jhooks@tcboe.org for your snapcode if needed. Students will not be placed in a class until this process is completed.
- Class roles will be posted on August 7, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. in the front of the school.
- We will not be having in person Meet the Teacher this year. Your child's teacher will be sending home a letter and calling you before school begins on August 20. Teachers will also post a classroom tour video on the LES webpage for students to familiarize themselves with the room.
- At this time visitors will not be allowed in the building. Access will be restricted to TCBOE personnel, approved contractors/workers, and TCBOE students.
- Parent meetings will be conducted online or via telephone.
- Per Governor Ivey's current mask order, children over six will be required to wear a face covering. Those under six are encouraged but not required. Mask should avoid advertising alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, mature content, or political messaging.
- Parents are asked to check students' temperatures daily and keep them at home should they have a temperature of 100.4 or higher. Please keep them at home if they exhibit symptoms such as cough, congestion, sore throat, trouble breathing, gastrointestinal issues, and loss of smell or taste.
- If a child begins exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms during the school day, they will be stationed in the LES Care Center and you will be contacted to come get them.
- LES staff will check student and employee temperatures daily.

- LES supply drop-off will be following the schedule below. 1st-5th grade students will also do device pick-up at the same time. We will also distribute car tags on these days as well.
- In order to pick-up a device, parents will need to have completed online device orientation, completed Powerschool registration that includes device use permission, and pay the \$25.00 device fee.
