Yearbooks will be on sale from October 5 to November 12. The cost is \$25. Please send cash, check (written to MES), or money order with your student to turn in to their teacher.

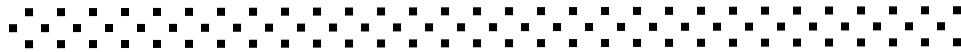

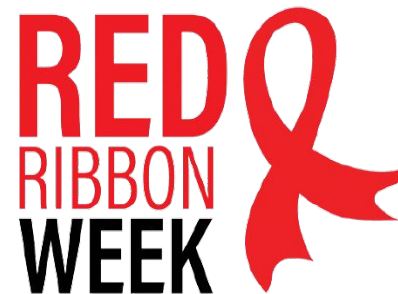

What's Happening at MES?



MES students will participate in Red Ribbon Week October 25-29. Red Ribbon week is a drug prevention awareness campaign. Throughout the week students will engage in activities centered around the dangers of drug use. Students can also participate in dress up days as follows:

- **Monday, October 25** - "Proud to Be Drug Free" - Wear RED
- **Tuesday, October 26** - "Drugs Can't Find Me" - Wear CAMO
- **Wednesday, October 27** - "Wacky Wednesday -From Head to Toe, I'm Drug Free" - Wear crazy hair, socks, and mismatched clothes
- **Thursday, October 28** - "Too Cool For Drugs" - Wear sunglasses
- **Friday, October 29** - "Scare Drugs Away" - Wear Halloween costume (no costume masks, plastic weapons, etc)

MES students have the opportunity to participate in the Be a Champion and Read Contest. Students first choose to read for either the University of Alabama or Auburn University.
