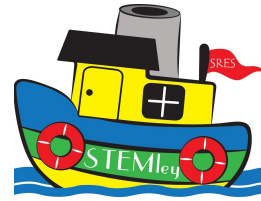


Stemley Road Elementary School Parent and Family Engagement Plan 2020-2021
