Kindergarten:

Students will demonstrate proficiency by all students mastering a minimum of 85% of sight words by 5/23/19 as measured by grade-level assessments.

3rd Grade:

Students will demonstrate growth by increasing the percentage of students scoring in the proficient/benchmark category by 15% by 5/23/19 as measured by Scantron assessments.

First, Second, Fourth, & Fifth Grades:

Students will demonstrate growth by increasing the percentage of students scoring in the proficient/benchmark category by 15% from August 2018 to May 2019 as measured by STAR Reading assessments.

Kindergarten:

Students will demonstrate growth by increasing the percentage of students scoring in the proficient/benchmark category by 15% by 5/23/19 as measured by Scantron assessments.

First, Second, Fourth, & Fifth Grades:

Students will demonstrate growth by increasing the percentage of students scoring in the proficient/benchmark category by 15% from August 2018 to May 2019 as measured by STAR Math assessments.

Students with Disabilities -Reading and Math Goals:

Seventy percent of students with disabilities will increase student growth by one grade-level equivalency by 04/30/19 as measured by STAR Assessments.

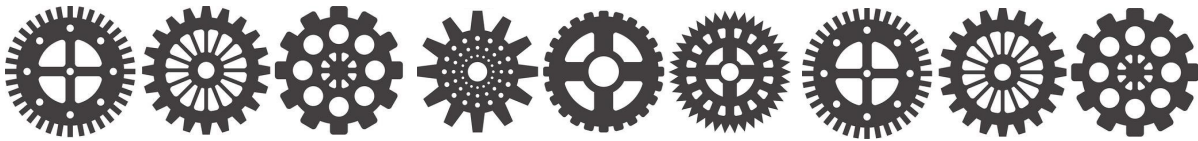
