

Munford Middle School Parent Guide for School Reopening - August 2020

Drive-thru Orientation July 29 9:00 - 4:00 Make-up day July 30 2:00-5:00	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Chromebooks may be picked up at this time. ● Registration through PowerSchool MUST be complete. ● Fees can be paid through PayPams or at this time: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ General/locker fee \$10 ○ Chromebook fee \$40 includes protection plan OR \$25 does NOT include protection plan ● Schedules can be picked up during the “Drive-thru Orientation”. ● If you do not pick up your schedule on this day, you will receive your schedule on the first day of school.
Blended Phase Learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● During “in-school” days, students will receive instruction from the teachers, participate in learning activities and assessments, and download any necessary assignments. ● During home learning days, students will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ complete assignments from each class that are assigned by the teachers.
Arrival & Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students may NOT enter the building prior to 7:30. ● Students may NOT be dropped off to wait outside the school door. ● Students will have staggered dismissal times based on bus riders, car riders, athletes, and students riding home with high school students.
Social Distancing Efforts	
Hallway	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Time in hallways will be limited. ● Students will only visit lockers during arrival, before and after PE, and prior to dismissal. ● Hallway markers will identify the direction students should travel. ● Students should travel in single-file lines while in the hallway. ● Students will not be allowed to congregate in the hallways. ● Water fountains will not be open for use.
Classrooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Student seating will be spaced as much as possible. ● Partner/collaborative work will be limited. ● When possible, students will not share supplies. ● If supplies are shared, they will be sanitized before and after use.
PE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● PE will take place daily. ● Students will participate in no-contact activities. ● Equipment will be sanitized after each class.
Sanitizing Efforts	
Restrooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Restrooms will be wiped down between every class change.
School-wide &	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The school will be sanitized twice per week, at the end of the day on Fridays,

Classrooms	<p>and after school on Wednesdays.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students will wipe down their desk at the beginning and end of each class. ● Teachers will spray at the end or beginning of each class. ● Students will have access to hand sanitizer.
Additional Information	
Temperature Check	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Staff and students will receive daily temperature checks upon arrival at school each day.
Masks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Based on the current order by the Governor, masks/face covering are required for all staff and students. ● Masks should be a solid color. ● Masks may have a school logo or school mascot. ● Masks may have the student's name or initials on the inside. ● Masks should not have any other text or writing.
Breakfast/Lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Breakfast will be served in a "grab and go" format. Students will eat breakfast in their homeroom classroom. ● Students will pick up their lunch from the lunchroom and eat in their 4th period classroom.
Attendance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● If your child is absent due to possible COVID-19 symptoms, absences can be recorded in two new ways in order to not penalize students. ● If your child is kept home for flu-like symptoms and does not visit the doctor, <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ A parent note may be submitted. ○ The note must include the symptoms experienced during the absence. ● "COVID Quarantined Exposure" and "COVID Quarantined Positive" codes will be used when necessary. Medical documentation must be submitted to the school for positive cases. ● Staff and students may return to the school after one of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Submit a doctor's release ○ After a 14 day quarantine AND fever-free for at least 72 hours ● Check-ins and check-outs should be limited and will take place at the school door.
Visitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Parents/visitors will not be allowed to visit the school - including eating lunch or volunteering. ● Appointments are required for meetings with teachers and/or administrators. ● Conferences will be held virtually when possible.
Buses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Buses will operate as normal at ½ capacity. ● All bus riders will have assigned seats with family members. ● Buses will be sanitized after each morning and evening route. ● At this time, masks are required during the duration of the bus ride.
Field Trips	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Field trips will not be approved at this time. ● FBLA may participate in field trips based on state guidelines and expectations.
