

Car Rider Safety Procedures

Morning:

1. Car rider line will begin at 7:30 a.m. and end at 8:00 a.m. Parents will make **one** line in front of the school.
2. Use the designated carline. Do not park and walk your child across unless you have a scheduled meeting.
3. Please do not let your child exit the vehicle without a faculty member present.
4. If your child needs assistance exiting the vehicle turn your flashers on to notify the faculty.
5. Pull all the way forward accept when leaving space at the crosswalk providing handicap access at the front of the building.

Afternoon:

1. Car rider line will begin at 2:45 p.m. and end at 3:10 p.m. Parents will make **two** lines in front of the school during dismissal time.
2. No individual will be permitted to pick up a student without a car tag. If you do not have your tag, please plan to park and come inside with ID to get your child.
3. All adults should remain in their vehicles during car rider pick up. Staff members are present outside to assist with loading.
4. If your child needs help buckling their seat belt or car seat harness, pull into the parking lot after your child has loaded.
5. Pull all the way forward accept when leaving space at the crosswalk providing handicap access at the front of the building.
6. The use of tobacco products is prohibited on school property at all times.
7. Car riders concludes each day at 3:10 p.m. If you are not in line by this time, you will need to park and come inside to pick up your child.

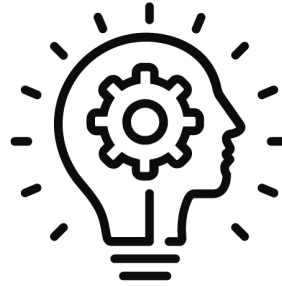
Our New Assistant Principal: MRS. MANDY WATTS
