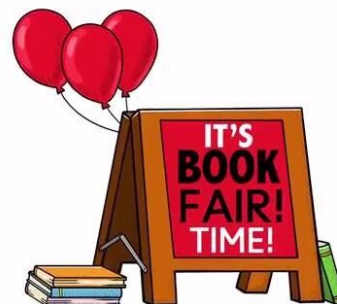

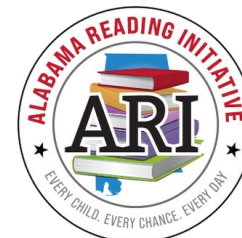


# What's Happening at MES?
