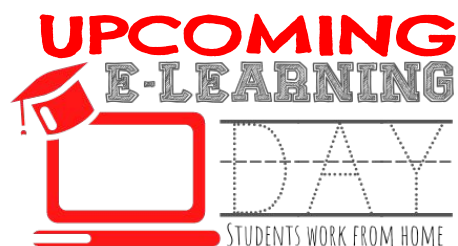


Accelerated Reader
